

Downloading Apps for Purchase: The Process

1. Do some investigation of the app.
 - How did you hear of the app?
 - Do you know anyone else who is using it? If so, who? How is it being used?
 - Investigate the app. What do the reviews say on the app store?
 - Investigate the developer. What do we know about the company? **What is the privacy policy?**
2. Bring your findings to your building principal, who will work with you to decide whether or not to purchase the app for you to work with and preview.
3. If downloading the app is approved, work with it for a while and complete the app evaluation tool.
4. Make a recommendation whether to purchase for a larger group based on your findings.
5. Present the recommendation to your building principal, who will work with you to decide whether or not the app should be purchased or can be purchased for a larger group.
6. Upload the app evaluation to a shared place for NWCS staff to access.
7. Present the information to technology for purchase and installation.
