**MAX RINGGER** - Max is the son on Kurt & Trisha Ringger.

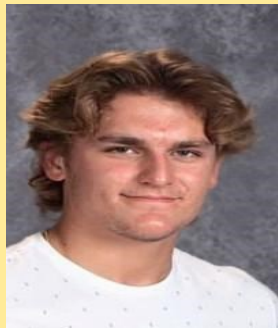
Max is a four year member of the Norwell Football program. He dove on the swim team for a season, ran track for a year and was a manager for the basketball team for one season.
