Meal cost at all of the buildings:

Norwell Middle School	\$2.85	\$1.85

Reduced Students	\$ .40	\$ .30
Milk only	\$.70	\$.70

According to the federal guidelines, if a student only wants to purchase a milk, regardless of free or reduced status, the cost is \$.70. To have a meal count a complete meal a student must have a fruit or vegetable and at least two other items.

Your elementary student will not be able to charge over \$15.00. Before your student has reached the maximum amount of -15.00, a note will be sent home. Middle school and High School Students are unable to charge, and can receive an alternate meal of a cheese sandwich and milk. We encourage you to pay ahead, weekly or monthly, and not let your lunch bill get delinquent. It is the responsibility of the parent to know how much money is in your student's account. You may call your student's school and speak to food service or the food service director at 260-622-4125 ext. 1004, you can check balances on PowerSchool (this may not be current and can take up to 24 hours to update), or start an account at [myschoolbuck.com](http://myschoolbuck.com). You can also add money to your student's account at [myschooolbucks.com](http://myschooolbucks.com) by using a credit card (there is a small fee for this service).
