_____ Black or African American: A person having origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa.

_____ Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands.

_____ White: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, the Middle East, or North Africa.
