eLearning Plan 2021-2022

1. When an eLearning day is called students are expected to follow the 2-Hour Delay Schedule they follow when we are in school
 - eLearning Schedule: 9:40 – 2:30
2. Attendance will be taken at the start of each period with the exception of related arts
3. You must be on the Teams meeting at the start of each period with the exception of related arts
4. If you are not on the Teams meeting at the start of each period, you will be counted absent
5. If you are late to the Teams meeting you will be counted Tardy
6. NMS Handbook policy will be used during eLearning days
7. Related Arts classes will not take attendance at the regular scheduled time on eLearning days
 - Related Arts teachers will have students download and/or upload assignments to Schoology for completion the day we have eLearning.
 - Students must complete the assignments for related arts by 2:30 the day of eLearning and send them to their related arts teachers
 - If you do not complete your related arts assignments by 2:30 you will be counted absent
 - If you are unable to complete your related arts assignments by 2:30 you must communicate this with your related arts teacher(s)
8. If you are sick on the day of eLearning, you must notify the school that you will be absent from eLearning
9. If you have technology issues, you must communicate with your teacher(s) and/or call the technology office (phone number is located on our webpage)
10. You do not have 5 days to complete your assignments.
11. Absences and tardies during eLearning days can lead to disciplinary action
12. Remember an eLearning day counts as one of the 180 required days of school.
